Africa's Greatest Living Adventurer

Kingsley Holgate, well know humanitarian and adventurer, together with his family and team of explorers were hosted by The Point Hotel recently during the final week of their circumnavigation of the African continent.

The explorers traveled through 33 countries by land with Land Rovers and by inflatable boats. Supported by amongst others, British Airways, the motive behind the trip was humanitarian as well as exploratory. The One Net One Life project distributed over 100 000 mosquito nets and sprays to pregnant woman and children in an effort to combat the dire consequences of malaria

Teaching on The Edge distributed educational materials to rural schools and Rite to Site distributed reading glasses to those who would otherwise not have access to them. The team who have been on the road for since July 2007 will end their travels in Cape Town July 2008.

Willem Viviers, General Manager of The Point Hotel was thrilled to sign the Africa - The Outside Edge Expedition's Scroll of Peace, endorsed by Archbishop Desmond Tutu and ex-president Nelson Mandela. The scroll has throughout the journey been inscribed by more than 5000 people and was carried together with a calabash of sea water taken from Cape Point - the starting point of the journey.
